 3. **BUY** a frozen turkey* at your local grocery store and bring it to WSCAH at the following dates and times:

Friday Nov. 18	8AM- 6:30 PM
Monday Nov. 21	8AM-8 PM
Tuesday Nov. 22	8AM- 8 PM

*Small turkeys up to 12 lbs. and turkey breasts strongly preferred
